Privacy policy (cookies) of the website europejski.pl

- 1. The website www.europejski.pl ("Website") automatically collects only information contained in cookie files.
- 2. Cookie files are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored in the end device of the user of the website www.europejski.pl. Cookies contain the name of the website they come from, a unique number and the storage time on the end device. Cookies do not contain any personal data.
- 3.
